



- Take a left at Valley Street (at the second stoplight) and we immediately are on the left





The purpose of this gathering is to make a big church smaller. This will be a great environment for students to explore the various ministry opportunities of Brook Hills while finding great community, encouragement from the Word, and connection to a small group, the core of our ministry. COMMUNITY


