Indent the second line of two-line headings approximately 1/4 inch beyond the first line.

BIBLIOGRAPHY and APPENDICES (or APPENDIXES) should be typed at the left margin.

Appendix letters should be aligned with chapter numbers (½ inch beyond the left margin), and appendix titles should be aligned with chapter titles (1/2 inch beyond appendix letters.).

> Maintain a 1½ inch left margin for the entire dissertation (beginning with the title page and continuing through the last page of the last appendix).
